Library

- Shared library catalogue
- Common loaning polices
- Shared electronic materials and databases

Artistic studies / research

University of the Arts trains artists and educates students to other occupations: teachers, music technicians, music managers etc.

The artist produces an art work and researches the creative process.

Doctoral study is typically an original combination of artistic and theoretical approaches.

Training artists in an university and artistic research tradition, influences information literacy education.



New students / orientation period

Library premises and services ; short introduction to databases and some search exercises. Includes in "Study planning" at the curriculum (2 credits)



Bachelor students

- IL education is integrated into undergraduate seminar period
- Music education ; Church music, Early music
- 4 x 45 min. workshops
- Basics of information seeking process ; subjects of the students' own bachelor's theses



Master students

- IL education is integrated into graduate seminar period (music education)
- Deepening information seeking skills
- Workshop activities

- Research skills : Library as a resource for research
- In cooperation with DocMus and MuTri doctoral schools

- + Takes into account of differencies between training programmes
- + Personal
- Systematic IL education is not available in all training programs
- Depends a lot of activity of teachers and training programs
